## **g) Second Hand Uniform Sales**

- There was an accumulation of gear and after a few hours of sorting we were able to run a well organised sale. Thank you to everyone who helped on the day - Julie, Marie, Alexis and Emma. Feedback from the community was very positive and they are looking forward to the next sale. We will aspire to continue with collections of old uniforms for another sale possibly end of term 2.

## **h) T-Shirts**

- It has been mentioned previously that we could organise tshirts for the houses for sports day. Michael has indicated that he is happy for us to do this as a fundraiser.
- The design would be simple, tshirts of house colours with a St Thomas's logo on the front and the house and image on the back.
- We could sell them for around \$20 to cover the cost and make a margin as a fundraiser.

## I) Fundraising

### i) Chocolate Sales (Alexis)

- Unfortunately, the board voted rather strongly against a chocolate fundraiser. Reasons cited were that it would conflict with our healthy food policy and thus a source of mixed messages to students, while additionally that often parents end up paying for the whole box.

### ii) Doodle Boards (Luke)

- Year 1 – year 5 students white board use in class is significant thus Luke has been trialling in class.
- Durable, environmentally friendly ie; saves paper, save work option means work can be connected to a printer to be printed, plus erase option, great to exhibit work, classroom popularity noticed by Luke.
- Special stylus or can use finger, inspires engagement and motivation, lefties love it!
- 6 colour choices, light and easy to transport, space saving, battery life is quite long, small C20 disc battery.
- Luke suggests 2 particular sizes of doodle board are recommended as best use in class and a vast improvement to use versus current whiteboard use.
- A reasonable option for fundraising 12-inch RRP \$35 and 20-inch RRP \$45, propose ordering 300 and profit of approx \$1600
- Too great of an outlay to prepurchase for sales, pre sale option to be explored.
