How you can help at home:

- Read with your child hear them read as often as possible - books, magazines, menus, instructions on board games, the itinerary for a trip away
- Let them hear you read a paragraph, a page, a chapter
- Read the same books as your child and discuss them afterwards
- Listen to audiobooks whilst driving

Questions to ask while/after reading to gauge understanding:

Remembering:

- What happened after...?
- How many...?
- Who was it that...?
- Can you name the ...?

Understand

• What do you think could of

happened next...?

- Who do you think...?
- What was the main idea...?

Questions to ask while/after reading to gauge understanding:

<u>Apply</u>

- What factors would you change if...?
- Can you apply the method used to some experience of your own...?
- What questions would you ask of...?

<u>Analyse</u>

- What do you see as other possible outcomes?
- Why did ... changes occur?

Questions to ask while/after reading to gauge understanding:

<u>Evaluate</u>

- Is there a better solution to...?
- Do you think ... is a good or a bad thing?
- How would you have handled...?
- What changes to ... would you recommend?

<u>Create</u>

- Can you see a possible solution to...?
- If you had access to all resources how would you deal with...?
- Why don't you devise your own way to deal with...?
