Corban Estate Arts Centre

The Year 3 classes went to Corban Estate Arts Centre on a school trip earlier this term. Our bus was a little late, we saw a train on the way there. It took ages to get there but we got there in the end. There were three people teaching us. We received lots of instructions on how to make a pinch pot. First, we designed our pinch pot, secondly, we made pinch pots out of clay, and third, we painted our pinch pot. It was so much fun, and a very long day! They are called pinch pots because you must pinch them to form the shape. Some of us made large pots, but then they became too fragile and crumbly, so they needed to be rolled it into a ball, a hole needed to be punched into the ball to create a pot. We then decorated around them with more clay. After we made our pots, they were to go into a kiln which is a giant oven for hardening pots. Then they will get dipped into a white glaze that dries into glass and then the pots will go into the kiln again.

During lunch we played by the giant Pohutukawa trees. Soon we made our way back to school on the bus, which was rather noisy! We are expecting to receive our pots any day now!
