## Treaty of Waitangi (Te Tiriti o Waitangi) Policy

To ensure that St Thomas's School implements the provisions and intents of the Treaty of Waitangi by

- 1. Having the curriculum reflect Maori perspective.
- 2. Encouraging students and staff to understand and take pride in our Maori heritage.
- 3. Developing a sense of cultural awareness and identify across the school.
- 4. Providing opportunities to enhance the students' and staff knowledge and appreciation of Maori culture, Te Reo and Tikanga Maori.
- 5. Recognising Maori values in resourcing the school.

## Guidelines

- 1. Te Reo Maori will be an integral part of the teaching and learning programmes.
- 2. Appropriate equitable provision will be made in the curriculum for the instructional needs of Maori children.
- 3. Opportunities will be provided for all students to learn Tikanga Maori.
- 4. Curriculum planning will ensure Maori perspectives are embodied in the content, methodology and assessment.
- 5. Teaching strategies will utilise Maori examples.
- 6. Maori values and customs will be, as far as practicable, incorporated into school life.
- 7. Budgeting will reflect the need to implement the Treaty.
