	Behaviour	Consequences
Step 1	Breaking classroom expectations.	Verbal warning given by teacher.
Step 2	<ul> <li>A second instance of breaking classroom expectations.</li> <li>One-off playground teasing, inappropriate comments.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Teachers discretion for consequence.</li> <li>Appropriate options would be:         <ul> <li>Time out</li> <li>Verbal warning</li> <li>Removal of in-class privileges</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Step 3	<ul> <li>Defiance or non-compliance.</li> <li>Intentional verbal harm towards people (e.g. threats, verbal aggression).</li> <li>Intentional harm towards equipment.</li> <li>Repeated breaking of classroom expectations or Class Treaty rules.</li> <li>Intentional physical contact with another student (not causing injury).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Time out in own or other class.</li> <li>Teacher to enter details into eTap including detail of consequence applied.</li> <li>Withdrawal of EOTC privileges (e.g. sport, school representation). Note: behaviour consequences have priority over any other school commitments.</li> <li>Parents notified by phone or email by the classroom teacher. Year Level Leader to be copied in and student to be added to Pastoral Care for team meeting.</li> </ul>
Step 4	<ul> <li>Inappropriate classroom behaviour continues long term despite consequences applied.</li> <li>Repeated defiance / non-compliance.</li> <li>Swearing or obscene gestures at an adult/student.</li> <li>Theft.</li> <li>Bringing the reputation of the school into disrepute.</li> <li>Repetitive verbal harm towards people.</li> <li>Intentional physical harm (injury) caused.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Deputy Princiapl informed.</li> <li>Student withdrawn from playground to undertake supervised rubbish duty (classroom teacher to formally hand student over to duty teacher).</li> <li>Parents notified by Deputy Principal.</li> <li>Meeting may be arranged between student, teacher and parents.</li> <li>Contract may be drawn up for student detailing future expectations and consequences.</li> <li>Deputy Principal to enter details into Hero.</li> </ul>
Step 5	<ul> <li>Continuation or escalation of above behaviours.</li> <li>Severe physical harm caused.</li> <li>Serious damage to property.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Deputy Principal or Principal informed.</li> <li>Student withdrawn from playground to undertake supervised rubbish duty (classroom teacher to formally hand student over to duty teacher).</li> <li>Parents notified by Deputy Principal.</li> <li>Withdrawal of all privileges.</li> <li>Meeting arranged between student, teacher, parents and SLT.</li> <li>Principal to decide on consequence and referral to Board of Trustees.</li> <li>DP/Principal to enter details into Hero.</li> </ul>
